THE 10 YEARS OF SOS CHILDREN'S VILLAGES AND DPDHL PARTNERSHIP

Young people from vulnerable backgrounds face tremendous challenges when embarking on their journey towards self-reliance. They are more likely to experience obstacles like discrimination, lack of skills, lack of networks, role models and at times lack of social skills and self-esteem than those who grow up in stable, protective family environments.

The partnership between SOS Children's Villages and Deutsche Post DHL Group supports young people on their way to independence and to becoming active members of society. In the past ten years, we have achieved tremendous global impact in the frame of GoTeach by empowering vulnerable young people and providing them with the necessary experience and self-confidence to take control of their future and to build stable and independent adult lives.

Through joint partnership activities, young people expand on their social and professional networks, develop a career plan and orientation, gain their first experience in the workplace, build self-confidence and motivation for their own future, and improve on valuable job-specific and soft skills. Simultaneously, GoTeach creates impact for DHL employees as it enables them to assume a role model function, to feel a contribution to society, to increase overall job satisfaction and to improve employee engagement within the workplace.

Our partnership went far beyond the expectations we had at the start, and yet it is just the beginning. Since 2011, we have reached over 20.000 young people. The programme, which started with a kick-off in Madagascar way back in 2011, is already 54 National Partnerships strong. The foundation of this successful partnership is mutual trust and equal collaboration, which we have been able to establish between our organizations. A unique partnership spirit based on co-creation, openness and joint values, our "One Team" approach has been acknowledged through various awards and recognitions including the EU Sustainability Award 2019. Most recently, we won the World Sustainability Leader Award 2021 in the External Partnerships category.

As a long-standing partnership, GoTeach serves as a blueprint and an example of success in forming impactful partnerships for the development of similar youth employment programmes. The GoTeach programme paved the way for the expansion not only to other countries, but also to other corporate partnerships at SOS and to the creation of a multi-stakeholder platform – YouthCan! In 2017 - focusing on youth employability.

We came so far only through contribution of various stakeholders, who are central to our GoTeach program. To mark our ten years anniversary we invited them to share their personal reflection on GoTeach! Not only was food short but school supplies were also insufficient.



I was afraid to express myself for fear of saying hurtful things because I was angry with the whole world" Bridget explained. Bridget attended SSS Bambous until the age of 16. After that she took a painting, embroidery and plumbing course at the Mauritius Institute of Training and Development (MITD). "I wanted to learn plumbing and told myself that if a water pipe broke in the house, I could fix it."

Bridget participated in the youth empowerment programme which led to taking part in GoTeach where she started thinking about her future. I dream of becoming a chef one day.

The GoTeach programme helped her to plan a career. Despite reading and writing difficulties Bridget was so motivated that she started a functional literacy programme. This gave me strength and the other training in the GoTeach was easy. I was boosted-up through peer-to-peer sharing with the GoTeach team.

On the advice of SOS Children's Villages to upgrade her skills, Bridget attended a job interview at a well-known hotel and was hired as a kitchen helper. With her salary, Bridget helped her mother to obtain a house in the centre of Mauritius.

Currently, I am an employee at DHL Togo with a fixed-term contract as a Service Point Agent. It is a fantastic experience that I am having thanks to the GoTeach programme. I had to do a two-week immersion in the company, then a three-month internship, and then a sixmonth fixed-term contract. I am very motivated and grateful for this great opportunity to work and learn because I am indeed learning a lot.

DHL Togo is a company that allows development on several levels: leadership, knowledge of an international company, global information. Thanks to DHL, I am on the lookout for news because everything that is done at DHL is linked to the changes that are taking place on the economic and political levels.

We are often told that the work environment is another world. I had the opportunity to experience this: how to live together, how to be with your colleagues, how to manage stress and so on. At the beginning I was super stressed, but with time I was able to integrate and assimilate the work that is done at DHL.

I entered SOS Villages Children in February 1994, four days after my birth.

I first heard about GoTeach in 2017 when the program was launched in Burundi. At that time I was doing my Bachelor in Finance in Uganda, which I completed in 2019. When I returned back to Burundi, I spent 4 months seeking a job, all in vain. Then I remembered that there was a partnership between DHL and SOS Children's Village Burundi. So I went to the SOS CV office and got the promise that they would see how to get an internship for me.

I started my Internship in DHL last year, which was supposed to last for 3 months. I was so excited to start my Internship that I arrived at the DHL office at 7 AM. I got a warm welcoming from the whole DHL Burundi Staff. It was a wonderful beginning.

After one month the management team called me in and told me that my internship had been cancelled, I was badly surprised before she added "We want you to join our team". That was greatest day of my life. So I started working in customer service as an employee. And I haven't had any challenges because my supervisor was open and willing to respond to all questions that I had. As a Go Teach Ambassador I would like to see the level of unemployment decreasing by encouraging youth to start with small businesses in order to get revenue so that they can engage themselves in what they really want to do afterwards.

The project changed my view of the world and taught me that, as a young person, I must always question, study and remain confident. Thanks to everyone who made me the young woman I am today.





I joined in autumn 2010 when it was unclear if the cooperation between the Deutsche Post DHL Group and SOS Children's Villages International would really happen. The partnership has now advanced for 10 years and a lot has been achieved.

Here is a little story:

What was the situation in 2010?

I was approached as an external consultant when it was unclear whether months of preparation and negotiations would finally work out. Deutsche Post DHL Group had enthusiastic people who were well prepared: both they and SOS were professional and

competent, but there were two obstacles to solve on the way to a fruitful partnership, obstacles based on the organisational culture of the partners.

First obstacle.

Both were acting and negotiating from their European based Headquarters, trying to set standards, structures and solutions that would work all over the world. Within GoTeach this had to change, so that "local-rooting" and "local ownership" became more important.

Second obstacle.

SOS Children's Village's connection to corporate partners had previously been mainly focused on fundraising and marketing. This needed a change of mind-set. The DPDHL approach was not one of corporate sponsorship but a programme-focused one, aimed at joining forces for the common goal of improving the employability of young people supported by SOS.

The solution.

Building trust in the common goal and in the local capacity of the countries was a challenging task for me but we finally managed to sign a contract. All the pilot countries in 2011 made the same two remarks: although the solutions and details of partnership are different in every country, this partnership is "the missing link" for young people. In a complex world, complex causes and greater goals can only be solved through cooperation and partnership. That's why 1+1 is sometimes more than 2.


SOS Children's Village Netherlands has supported youth employability programmes, mostly in Africa, for a long time. Although official unemployment rates are relatively low (11%), statistics hide a bitter reality: over 20% of African youth are neither employed, in education or training, and 2/3rds of those with a job have wages below 2\$/day, and living in a 'working poverty' vicious cycle. Reasons are manifold; in addition to poor education, lack of relevant networks and required social/workplace skills gives them little chance on the labour market. The African population will have doubled by 2050 and by then a billion young people will have entered the labour market. If one can't compete with those better networked and skilled, prospects for a decent job (and decent life) are low. We are therefore proud to collaborate with the DHL GoTeach programme; through our global programme, YouthCan! and, as an example from some of our other programmes, help youngsters to find direction in life, build self confidence and workplace social skills, and, being part of a network, help them to navigate their way on the labour market through job shadowing, internships and 1-to-1 coaching by experienced seniors. GoTeach is a big pioneering example of how partnerships with the corporate sector should look like.
